



Under the Licensing Act 2003, Responsible Authorities must be fully notified of applications and are entitled to make representations to High Peak Borough Council in relation to grant, variation or review of premises licences. All representations made by a responsible authority would be regarded as 'relevant' under the Act.

It is a requirement of the Act that, if you are seeking a new licence or wish to vary an existing licence, each one of the responsible authorities is supplied with a copy of your application at the same time you send your application to us. For applicants in the Borough of High Peak, those are as follows:

Should a premise straddle two boundaries the licensing authority in whose area the greatest part of the premises is situated will be the licensing authority for that premise. In rare cases where the premises is located equally in two or more areas, the applicant can choose which authority will be the licensing authority. Close liaison must be kept with both authorities in these instances.
