THE HIGH PEAK BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AND CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008

Notice is hereby given that the High Peak Borough Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to revoke the High Peak Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Orders 1998 – 2007.

The Order re-enacts the provisions of the 1998 – 2007 Orders but with additional provisions to reflect the transfer of Civil Parking Enforcement powers from the Police to the Borough Council. The level of charges applicable at the various car parks will be unaltered and the prescribed level of charge for Penalty Charge Notices will be at the nationally prescribed levels of £70 and £50.

The Order relates to the 23 Council owned car parks in Buxton, Castleton, Edale, Glossop, Hope, New Mills, including the free car parks in Chapel-en-le-Frith, Hadfield and Whaley Bridge.

A copy of the proposed Order and accompanying plans and the orders to be revoked, are available for inspection during normal office hours at the Town Hall, Buxton, the Council Offices, Hayfield Road, Chapel-en-le-Frith and at the Municipal Buildings, Glossop.
