Introduction

When to use this form

This regime is known as Local Authority Pollution Prevention and Control, LAPPC. Installations permitted under this regime are known as B installations. Use this form if you are sending an application for a permit for a waste oil burner rated at less than 0.4 MW, on which you intend to burn waste oil arising at your premises, to a Local Authority under the Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (as amended) ("the PPC Regulations").

This contains a list of other documents you may need to refer to when you are preparing your application, and explains some of the technical terms used.
