<p><u>1. GADLEY LANE</u></p> <p>When will this lane be resurfaced?</p>	<p>SBS JA – 581358</p> <p>Gadley Lane has been put forward several times for resurfacing as a result of inspections, but it is highly unlikely to be done due to financial restraints. It is inspected regularly and any actionable potholes are filled to keep it safe. Inspected 12th September and no actionable defects were found.</p>
<p><u>2. DEVONSHIRE ROAD</u></p> <p>Can the hedge be cut back to the line of the wall to allow access for mobility scooters along the pavement?</p>	<p>SBS JA – 581346</p> <p>Overhanging vegetation notices sent to 1) palace hotel, 2) palace mansions, 3) Farleigh No. 5, Marlborough Road, and 4) Devonshire Hall, on 12th September 2008.</p>
<p><u>3. BAKEWELL ROAD – RAISED PAVEMENT</u></p> <p>Can the vegetation be cut back at the Morrison's roundabout on the raised footway to allow access for pedestrians and mobility scooters?</p>	<p>SBS JA – 581349</p> <p>Work issued to care team on 12th September 2008. (WIS 35550-sw17-12/9/08).</p>
