Proposal	No votes for each priority
<p>The Launt – Fairfield</p> <p>Long term plans from the local community to plant a wildlife garden on land off Granby Road. Plans have been put on hold whilst building work commenced. Houses are now built – would make a big impact locally.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Top choice – 0 votes ➤ 2nd choice – 2 votes ➤ 3rd choice – 4 votes
<p>Spring Gardens</p> <p>Make a gap in the wall from Aldi side of Station Road into Spring Gardens car park at 2 points. One near the pedestrian crossing and the other out of the small triangular car park. At present there is only one official pedestrian exit out of this small car park.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Top choice – 0 votes ➤ 2nd choice – 2 votes ➤ 3rd choice – 15 votes
<p>Spring Gardens</p> <p>Create gazebo for buskers in Spring Gardens. Spring Gardens has too much clutter. The stone artwork has deteriorated and should be either restored or removed.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Top choice – 2 votes ➤ 2nd choice – 0 votes ➤ 3rd choice – 0 votes
<p>St John's Road</p> <p>Improve the path from St Johns Road across field to two points on Lismore Park Housing Estate. Apparently public right of way, it is believed the site is a Heritage Site. Path is very muddy etc.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Top choice – 0 votes ➤ 2nd choice – 0 votes ➤ 3rd choice – 0 votes
<p>Belvedere Terrace, Terrace Road</p> <p>Improved planting etc on the bank on the right as you approach the Market Place (Belvedere Terrace) would make a good visual impact for that part of Buxton.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Top choice – 0 votes ➤ 2nd choice – 0 votes ➤ 3rd choice – 1 vote

<p>Community notice board in Higher and Lower Buxton</p> <p>Community notice board so that groups can advertise their community events.</p> <p>Spring Gardens Shopping Centre management have been approached and they are currently looking into the idea of including a notice board inside their complex on Spring Gardens.</p> <p>It has been suggested putting a community group in charge of maintaining and changing posters. The estimated cost for this provision varies from £400 - £1400.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Top choice – 0 votes➤ 2nd choice – 1 vote➤ 3rd choice – 1 vote
<p>Repairs to the skate park and or provision for a covered area somewhere where young people could get together out of the rain.</p> <p>Skate park improvements to access for disabled users, and accessible play equipment in general in parks.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Top choice – 2 votes➤ 2nd choice – 6 votes➤ 3rd choice – 4 votes
<p>Refurbish Burbage Scout Hut</p> <p>The money could be used to refurbish Burbage Scout Hut, there are lots of new developments in Burbage. The Scout Hut would be a useful community facility.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Top choice – 0 votes➤ 2nd choice – 1 vote➤ 3rd choice – 1 vote

<p>Church Street, Buxton</p> <p>Improve the two access points, renovate the stone pathway to rediscover the stone sets which used to follow the drainage line down the middle of this ancient street and to put in Victorian street lights.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Top choice – 1 vote➤ 2nd choice – 1 vote➤ 3rd choice – 0 votes
<p>Pavilion Gardens</p> <p>We would like to propose the installation of street lighting/flood lighting in the general garden area of the Pavilion Gardens, which is used by a large number of people returning from evenings out in Buxton and/or the Opera House (and potentially the Food Fair!!). The few lights which are there at the moment are highly insufficient, and the area can become quite threatening. Particularly for visitors who are unsure of what to expect. It may even help to deter the collection of teenagers who currently congregate there and benefit from the darkness.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Top choice – 17 votes➤ 2nd choice – 2 votes➤ 3rd choice – 0 votes
<p>Buxton in Bloom 2007</p> <p>Some of the money could be used to help Buxton in Bloom 2007 to get a gold award. Help with local projects working with schools and use some of the money to put barrier troughs around Buxton as they looked really good last year.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Top choice – 1 vote➤ 2nd choice – 2 votes➤ 3rd choice – 1 vote
