



CASTLETON ACTION GROUP **VILLAGE ACTION PLAN 2003**

This document forms the final part of Castleton's Village Plan and should be read in conjunction with the Village Appraisal document.

The village questionnaire received approx. 38% return.

The Action Plan has been developed BY the community, FOR the community.

As part of the Consultation Process an Open Day was held on 13th September 2003 to which village residents and village groups were invited. Volunteers and groups came forward to sign up for the many project proposals, and to take up any issues arising from the village appraisal which they were interested in developing. Additionally, village groups were further consulted to identify any needs which they felt were important within our community. The Action Group also wanted to identify new community groups setting up. All of these have been included in the Action Plan.

This document shows the projects taken up at the Open Day, and identifies those who may wish to be involved in them.

We are prioritising the projects where there are people willing to take them forward. The timescale indicates when a project is expected to start.
