8.1 Environmental and social group

Short Term

- Litter, Re-Cycling & Cleaner Streets

To provide more litter bins

To improve re-cycling facilities

To increase the rate of street cleaning

To eliminate dog fouling in public places by education and provision of dog waste bins

Medium Term/ Long Term

- Provision of Public Toilets

To reinstate the existing toilet block or

To replace with a modern facility

- Form 'Friends of Chinley Park' group

To promote the park as a wild life refuge and quiet area

To gain status as Conservation Area

8.2 Public Transport group:

Short Term

- Setting up parish wide transport group
- Addressing ticket pricing anomalies
- Establishing Friends of Chinley Station Group
- Promotion of Car Sharing website

Medium Term

- More train services to Stockport
- Early morning train service from Chinley
- Provision of request stop facilities at Chinley
- Address car parking situation at Chinley Station from a planning perspective
- Improvements to bus timetables in the local area
- Better integration of bus and train services

Chinley, Buxworth and Brownside Parish Plan

- Inclusion of taxi/minibus services in transport strategy

Long Term

- Disabled access to station
- Arranging new bus services to Hayfield and Glossop

8.3 Highways and Footpaths group

Short/Medium Term

Traffic -Adequate and clear signage.

- Clean or replace signs
- Tree and shrub pruning/trimming programme so that signs remain visible

Surface Water Drainage

- Land owners not to discharge surface water directly on to Dolly Lane.
- Derbyshire County Highways department to complete work to road side channels and culverts.

Parking – in the centre of Chinley

- Representations to be made to High Peak Borough Council

Parking - Buxworth Primary School

- A barrier rail from the school gate to the Club car park to shorten the route.
- DCC Highways to paint zigzag yellow lines outside the school Gates.

Footpaths and Bridleways

- A parish map, showing rights of way, linking with adjoining parishes

8.4 Community and Leisure Group:

Short Term

- Launch the Chinley, Buxworth and Brownside Community Association which will act as the delivery organisation for relevant aspects of the Parish Plan.
- Decide on the best course of action for improving the football pitches in Chinley
- Improve communication about existing facilities and activities through notice boards and the development of a website

Medium Term

- Identify funding opportunities for the improvement of the football pitches in Chinley
- Work together to secure the future of the Youth and Community Centre and develop it as a community facility incorporating the ideas of the community raised through the consultation.
- Establish a sub group of the Community Association to organise community activities and events.

Long Term

- Apply for funding to support the development of new and/or improved sport, community and leisure facilities at the Youth and Community Centre in Chinley, Buxworth & Brownside Parish.

Community and Leisure intend to form a Community Association (as detailed in their individual section above.) This plan will be delivered by volunteers and agencies in the Parish. Progress will be monitored by the Community Association who will use the Plan as a guide to their activities over the next three years. The plan will be reviewed annually.
