Notice of Withdrawal of a Development Plan Document

Housing In Buxton Development Plan Document

Under section 22(1) of the Planning and Compulsory purchase Act 2004 and in accordance with section 37 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations, High Peak Borough Council gives notice that on 1st August 2007 the Housing in Buxton Development Plan Document was withdrawn. The Housing in Buxton Development Plan Document will therefore no longer be proceeded with and will not be submitted to the Secretary of State. All relevant documentation will be removed from Council Offices, libraries and the Council website.

The Housing in Buxton Development Plan Document was commenced in response to the Inspectors report following the Local Plan Inquiry to ensure sufficient housing supply to meet the Structure Plan requirement to 2011. Progress has been made in achieving this aim as the preferred site now has the benefit of planning permission. The additional sites for development suggested in the public consultation exercise will be taken forward and assessed as part of the Core Strategy, which will establish housing supply to 2026. The issues and options consultation on the Core Strategy will take place in March 2008.
