NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ON 25th MAY 2006 HIGH PEAK BOROUGH COUNCIL ADOPTED ITS STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (SCI).

This Statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 24 (4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations, 2004.

The adopted SCI and accompanying Inspector's Report can be viewed at Council Offices and at all local libraries. Both documents are also available to view online at www.highpeak.gov.uk.

A person aggrieved by the SCI may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the ground that the SCI is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. The application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting on 25th May 2006.

A person aggrieved by the SCI may also make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the SCI. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after 25th May 2006.
