

Please be aware that the process for renewing your Vehicle Licence requires that your application is submitted **no less than 14 days** before the licence is due to expire.

## Application Process for a Private Hire Vehicle Licence

All applicants must provide the following information with their application:

Fees	INFORMATION REQUIRED;	Tick
	You must provide a current Vehicle Registration Document on first	
	application.	
	You must provide a satisfactory MOT Certificate which is no more than 1	
	month old at the time of your Vehicle Licence Application.	
	You must provide evidence that all 'advisorys' on the MOT have been attended to.	
	You must provide a valid Insurance Certificate or Cover Note	
	Provide a Completed Vehicle Licence Application Form and Fee	
£180	- 1 Year Vehicle Licence (inc. brackets, plates / decals)	
	- 1 Executive Hire Dispensation Card and rear window sticker*	
	*A dispensation letter is required to be eligible for this	
	For a New Vehicle Application, the vehicle must have no damage	
	affecting the structural safety of the vehicle and must have no more than	
	75,000 miles on the odometer;	
	For a Renewal Application, when the vehicle reaches a recorded mileage	
	of 300,000 (as evidenced via the odometer/service records/maintenance	
	history or other documentation) they will be deemed inappropriate to be	
	licensed by the Authority as a Private Hire vehicle.	
	If you are applying for a dispensation from displaying plates you must	
	provide a written statement of the reasons why the Council should consider	
	a dispensation for this vehicle with your application.	
	From 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2017 any <b>NEW</b> or <b>replacement vehicle</b> must be a	
	single overall colour that is <b>NOT</b> Silver or Grey (unless you have a written	
	dispensation from the Licensing Authority). If you wish to apply for this	
	dispensation you must provide a statement of the reasons why the Council	
	should consider a dispensation for this vehicle with your application.	
	If you are <b>not</b> a licensed driver or operator with High Peak Borough	
	Council. You will need to make an application for a Basic Disclosure on-line	
	at https://www.disclosurescotland.co.uk/	
	The Disclosure must be no more than one month old at the time of your	
	Vehicle Licence application.
