Statement of Community Involvement (SCI): Adoption Statement

This Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 and gives notice that High Peak Borough Council formally adopted the Statement of Community Involvement on 25th October 2023.

The SCI sets out how, when, with whom and by what means the Council will engage with stakeholders and residents in the preparation of planning policy documents and on planning applications. It covers the Borough of High Peak (excluding the part of the Borough within the Peak District National Park boundary). The SCI was subject to public consultation over a 6 week period from January 19th to March 3rd 2023.

No modifications have been made to the document pursuant to the representations received and other relevant matters are listed in the Consultation Statement.

Persons aggrieved by the content of the SCI may apply to the High Court for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt the SCI in addition to any other legal remedies.
