







Fairfield Common A6 Roundabout August 2022 update

GALLIFORD TRY INTRODUCTION

Galliford Try is delighted to have been awarded the contract to deliver this project and we would like to say hello and welcome to the first of our project newsletters.

We intend to provide regular updates regarding the progress of the scheme. We will include a brief look at what work has been completed and a forecast of what work is to come over the following months.

We will also provide an overview of our support for community projects and added social value we bring locally whilst we deliver the project.

Working on behalf of High Peak Borough Council, in partnership with Derbyshire County Council and Homes England, we are constructing a roundabout along the A6 at Fairfield Common.

We aim to complete the project by late Autumn 2022.

The roundabout will provide access to land at Hogshaw and Waterswallows (Dale Lane) so that new homes can be built. These housing sites, and the proposal to build the roundabout, form part of the housing delivery policies within the adopted High Peak Local Plan.

Progress and upcoming works

Summary of works completed to July 2022

 Installation of the site compound including an energy saving hybrid generator and battery unit for the office unit.



- Stripped 1,500m³ of topsoil from the project area.
- Imported 1,200m³ of crushed stone to bring the east side of the project up to finished levels.
- Installed two underground surface water drainage soakaway tanks. Each 10mx10m and 3.5m deep.
- The highways drainage installation has started.





Summary of works planned for August 2022

Drainage works will continue throughout August.

On a positive note, we have worked closely with the drainage design team and have agreed a revised plan for of the drainage layout.

This will reduce the scope of drainage required and help to reduce the requirement for traffic management on the A6.



• Work will get underway to divert the existing gas main alongside the carriageway.
