There is no option to keep the school open while polling takes place as the safeguarding risk would be too high. Closing the school for polling, often multiple times in a academic year causes inconvenience as well as financial loss to parents and a loss of learning to children.
	Dinting cricket club was used post COVID and by the parameters used in the draft proposal would also be suitable. It has a large room, with good heating and lighting, a large car park and is accessible. When we challenges the return of polling to the school the year after we were told in was because it is not a central location and the road was a bit bumpy. We find this to be incorrect as the cricket club is less than a mile from the school and the parking is better"
