# Temporary traffic lights in place on Fairfield Road from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> September

We would like to let you know about our plans to install temporary twoway traffic lights on a 200 metre stretch of the A6 Fairfield Road from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> September. The lights will be positioned as shown below.

The lights will control the traffic in each direction, to help us safely complete the works on the new roundabout.

To help keep traffic delays to a minimum, our team will be on site from 7am to 7pm – 7 days a week to control the light timings by hand and shorten the distance affected if possible. The priority is to keep the traffic moving north so that delays are minimised in Buxton. We aim to remove the two way lights before the end of the year if possible.

The A5004 (Long Hill) remains closed whilst a landslip is repaired. It is hoped that the road will reopen under two way traffic lights from the 2<sup>nd</sup> October.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this may cause.
