Two properties in Buxton have been undergoing a major refurbishment after being awarded more than £350k of grant funding. The Buxton High Street Heritage Action Zone scheme, which has received funding from Historic England and High Peak Borough Council, has awarded significant grants to help conserve and reinstate shop fronts to two properties in the town centre. The works, which have already commenced, will see the properties, 1 of which has a listed status, given a new lease of life. Both properties will benefit from new shopfronts which will be based on historic photographs, stone repairs and re-pointing and Ponden Homes will also have new bay windows to the first floor.
