

## Former White Lion



The former White Lion pub in Buxton has undergone a major restoration scheme after being awarded just under £300k of grant funding through the Buxton High Street Heritage Action Zone. The 18<sup>th</sup> century building, which is Grade II listed, had previously fallen into disrepair after years of unsympathetic alterations, under use and vacancy which has resulted in the building being included on a county wide 'Buildings at Risk' register. Through the HAZ scheme, the owners were able to secure a grant to undertake urgent repair and restoration works to avoid the building falling into further deterioration. Grant aided works included structural and timber repairs, roof and rainwater repairs, pointing and stonework repairs, restoration of the existing sash windows, and reinstatement of traditional ground floor bay window to the front elevation.
